## Writing

Our class novel is called:

Pig Heart Boy by Malorie Blackman.



This novel is about a young

boy who needs a heart transplant. We will use this book to consolidate our learning in topic/science (where we are investigating the circulatory system) and to practise our reading and writing skills.

We will discuss ideas with partners and dramatize key events in the story. We will also continue work on grammar, spellings and punctuation.

#### **Homework**

#### <u>Numeracy</u>

We will be focusing on 'Number' including:

Place value, where we will practise reading, writing, comparing and ordering numbers to 10 million, rounding numbers to the nearest million and using negative numbers in a range of contexts.

Calculation, were the children will consolidate their knowledge of the formal methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and apply their understanding to a range of maths problems.

We will also be learning our times tables everyday. Please practise them at home too as they will help you in all areas of your maths!
